**Groundbreaking for the  
Memorial**

On September 22, at 5pm, just a few steps from the grave of legendary pioneer Daniel Boone, Bishop Ronald W. Gainer and Rev. Wayne B. Smith will officially break ground for the Kentucky Memorial for the Unborn in Frankfort Cemetery. This new landmark, being established on a bluff overlooking the Kentucky River and the state capital, will pioneer a new pathway for families to honor and find closure for unborn babies they have lost.

Until now, women and men who wanted to remember their unborn children carried them only in their hearts, because well-meaning family members often discouraged any grieving after a miscarriage and especially after an abortion. But giving no recognition to the short life carried in the womb has caused many citizens in our Commonwealth to bury unresolved grief, which time doesn't heal.

For them, this Memorial provides a unique place to symbolically lay their unborn baby to rest in the same dignified manner as they would any other family member. The black granite memorial wall that will bear inscriptions for each unborn child will stand as a comforting reminder that these children are now in the hands of our Creator, God. Over 70 requests have already been placed for inscription orders.

The groundbreaking service will celebrate the erection of a life-size bronze statue of *Rachel Weeping for Her Children*, sculpted by SL Jonson Studios in Nebraska, to promote interest in the monument and to help raise the \$97,000 needed to complete construction. The capital campaign's primary fundraising drive, the "**100 Church Challenge**," encourages churches throughout our state to commit to raising \$1000 each to meet the \$97,000 goal. Church sponsors will be recognized on a plaque to be placed near the monument.
